It is, indeed a rare honour and privilege for all of us to have Sh Rajendar Rana Ji to preside over the Raising Day Celebrations and the inauguration of the School Swimming Pool. Sir, we are immensely indebted and deeply thankful to you for having acceded to our request to be with us today, at such short notice. I also extend a very warm welcome to members of LBA, respected parents, members of OBA, Media and other esteemed guests to grace this momentous occasion.

Ladies and Gentlemen, like any other Sainik School, our aim at Sainik School Sujanpur Tira is to prepare the cadets, academically physically and mentally for entry into NDA and develop qualities of body, mind and character to enable them to become good and useful citizens of tomorrow. I am proud to announce that Sainik School Sujanpur Tira has been actively achieving this objective and is forging ahead to lead the tally. It is our school which has the unique distinction of having been awarded Raksha Mantri Trophy twice for sending maximum number of cadets to National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla during the last 25 years. This year also, I assure you ladies and gentlemen, that Sainik School Sujanpur Tira, will be preparing to send maximum number of cadets to NDA and other Armed Forces Academies.

Ladies and Gentlemen, in addition to achieving its primary aim, the school is also far- ahead in achieving its societal goal of education. Our students have turned out to be responsible and distinguished citizens of our country in various walks of life. In the school, the cadets undergo multifarious activities which develop within them the required mental and physical traits. Morning PT, Sports, Athletics, Water Sports, Gymnastics, Trekking, various hobbies Clubs and NCC camps are regular features of our curriculum. Debates, Declamations, Quiz completions, Dance, Drama, Skits and Extempore speeches also form our routine to sharpen the mental faculty of our cadets.

Now I shall present before you, a brief resume of the activities of the school during the session 2012-13.

ACADEMIC RESULTS

During the session 2012- 2013, in academics, our cadets posted impressive results in classes 10th and 12th CBSE Examination. In the internal examination also, in both the SA-I and SA-II examination, our cadets' performance has been better and praiseworthy in comparison to many other Sainik Schools throughout the country. Three cadets namely Cadet Ishan Rana, Cadet Prabhat and Cadet Aditya Kumar got 10 CGPA in 10th Class CBSE Board Examination. In 12th Class Board Examination, Cadet Kartikay Rana brought laurels to the school by scoring 99% marks in Chemistry and 97% marks in Physics and in total scored 94% marks.

UPSC & NDA

Keeping the primary aim of sending cadets to NDA, a comprehensive training programme is followed throughout the year for grooming the cadets. Cadets qualifying UPSC written examination undergo rigorous training for Service Selection Board which is imparted by the experts and resource persons from the institution and as well as from outside. During the session, 59 cadets appeared in the UPSC NDA Entrance Exam on 21 Aug 2012 at Shimla. 17 were successful and as many as 10 of them cleared the SSB Interview and finally 09 of them joined the NDA 130 course. The school has so far produced more than 425

officers for the Armed Forces through NDA only. Besides this, a large number of our ex-students have joined the Defence forces through IMA, OTA, AFMC, Air Force and Naval Academies. Further, the school has given to the nation a vast array of distinguished Bureaucrats, Doctors, Engineers, Bank Officers, Police Officers and Business Executives.

SCHOOLACTIVITIESANDACHIEVEMENTS

Besides normal academics, the school conducts a number of co-curricular activities and all major games and sports on Inter-House Competition basis to draw out the best in each individual cadet and build team spirit. Keeping the cadets' personality development in view, around 10 Clubs in various disciplines have been functioning in the school. To instill leadership qualities, prefectorial system has been incorporated in school administrative structure. The Investiture Ceremony, conferring badges to the cadet appointments at both school and House level was solemnly conducted in the month of April.

*To stimulate flight of creative imagination and language skills, the school has been organising competitions in Essay writing and in Creative Writing Skills. In the current session, the school organised such kind of competition for all the cadets of the school from 10 August to 20 August 2013.

*The National Talent Search Examination was conducted by SCERT Solan on 20th November 2012 at Govt. Senior Secondary School Sujanpur Tira. Out of 66 cadets who appeared in the said examination, 12 Of them were declared successful for NTSE Stage-11. Three cadets namely Abhishek Daroach, Parishruit Jassal and Kshitij Bhatia cleared the stage II and appeared for the final stage at Chandigarh.

* The School is greatly proud of its two cadets namely Abhay Chankrola and Akshay Thakur who were awarded Merit Certificates by the CBSE for their outstanding performance in All India Senior school Certificate Examination-2012 which are awarded in each subject to the top 0.01% of the successful candidates to recognize their meritorious performance

*Three cadets of class 10th namely Cadet Jatin Sahni, Prabhat Singh and Cadet Ishan Rana participated in the CBSE Cultural Heritage Quiz held at DAV Model School Chandigarh on 23 Nov 2012.

Games and Sports

* North Zone Inter Sainik Schools Sports Festival 2012 was held at Sainik School Kapurthala from 02 June to 07 June 2012. Our school, bagged first position in Football (Jrs), Hockey, Cultural Programme and second position in Football (Sub Jrs) and English Debate.

* Our school represented North Zone in sports discipline of Football and Hockey held at Sainik School Goalpara (Assam) and Sainik School Rewa (MP) and bagged overall 2nd position in both disciplines. Cadet Shubham Thakur was adjudged as the Best Scorer of the Tournament in the game of Football.

Educational and Motivational Tours

*The Educational and Motivational Tours are a welcome break for the cadets to refresh them from the hectic routine of the school. Keeping this factor in mind, 62 cadets of class 10th visited IMA Dehradun from 05 Jun to 07 Jun and witnessed the Commandant's Rehearsal of Passing Out Parade. During the tour they also visited the IMA Museum, Chetwood Hall and Down the Memory Lane.

*84 cadets of class 11th along with two teachers visited Agriculture University, Palampur (HP) on 12 June. The cadets visited the Museum. Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and Floriculture Department. *54 cadets of class 12th were sent for NDA Coaching at Cavalier Academy, Dehradun which was held from 18 June to 17 July

*77 Cadets of class 11th along with two officials of the school proceeded on a Motivational Tour to NDA Khadakwasla and its nearby places from 20th Dec. to 29th Dec 2012. During the tour, they visited INS Shivaji, Air Force Station and College of Military Engineering Secunderabad.

Camps and fairs

*A three day 'Book Fair' was organized from 14 June to 16 June in the school by Book Tractor. A wide range of books on different subjects were displayed in the Book Fair to the taste and the interest of the cadets.

*In order to foster the spirit of oneness and message of peace and National Integration amongst cadets, Communal Harmony Week was observed in the school from 19 Nov to 25 Nov 2012. To make the campaign a grand success, the school organised talks and speeches by the cadets and teaching staff on the allied topics.

*In addition to it , a three day Medical Camp was organized on 17, 18 and 19 Nov 2012 respectively under the Chief Minister's Students Programme. All the cadets were given free Medical Check-up and Medicines by the Community Health Centre Sujanpur Tira. For their continued support and affectionate care that's bestowed on our cadets we thank and salute the Department of Health of the Government of Himachal Pradesh.

NCC ACTIVITIES

*89 cadets of class 8th along with two cadets of class 9th attended Annual Training Camp held at Shahtali (Bilaspur) from 06 Oct to 13 Oct 2o12.

*10 cadets of class 9th attended Pre Directorate Combined Annual Training Camp-I held at Pirnigah (Una) from 08 Oct to 17 Oct 2012.

*05 cadets of class 9th attended Pre Directorate Combined Annual Training Camp-II held at Pandoh (Mandi) from 22 Oct to 02 Nov 2012.

*05 cadets of class 9th attended Pre Directorate Combined Annual Training Camp-I held at Ropar (Punjab) from 02 Nov to 11 Nov 2012.

*In addition to NCC related activities, the school organizes class-wise, time to time short- distance Trekking to give a welcome break to the cadets from the busy routine of the school. Such a trekking was organized for the cadets of class 10th to Balakrupi (Kangra) on 02 Dec 2012, 06 Kms away from the school.

Renovation/ Development Activities

Construction of Pathways with over head- cover from Hostels to School, really proved very helpful to the cadets, as this time it has been a prolonged Rainy season. All Play fields and courts, the school portico, the front of the school, School Assembly Hall and recently constructed School Cafe, all have been given a complete new outlook. Upgradation of training Infrastructure on a regular basis and keeping ourselves abreast of harnessing Technology into teaching-learning process are the key areas where special attention is given to. And today, the inauguration of the Swimming Pool by Shri Rajinder Rana Ji on behalf of the Hon'ble Chief Minister has added one more feather to the school crown to make it a public school in true sense.
